Abstracts not exceeding one A-4page (300 words) is to be submitted in electronic form by mail to icccdrhw@gmail.com. The abstract should be typed in Times New Roman, 12pt normal font, 1.5 line spacing containing a title fit into the theme/sub theme of the conference with the name(s) of author(s) and communication details with the email and telephone numbers. The name of the presenting author is to be made "bold and underlined". The contributors shall be intimated regarding the acceptance of their abstract, after which they can submit full manuscripts.

Full Paper should be typed in Times New Roman, 12pt normal font, 1.5 line spacing not exceeding 5000 words is to be submitted electronic form by mail to icccdrhw@gmail.com.

The paper should follow the APA style for references, with no more than 15% plagiarism.
